ELECTION OF 1 (ONE) DISTRICT COUNCILLOR FOR THE CALVER WARD

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT:

1. An Election is to be held for 1 (ONE) DISTRICT COUNCILLOR for the CALVER WARD of Derbyshire Dales District Council.

 - collected from The Town Hall, Matlock DE4 3NN (9am – 5pm)
3. Nomination papers **must be delivered by hand** to the Returning Officer, Derbyshire Dales District Council, Level 3 Meeting Room, Town Hall, Matlock DE4 3NN between the hours of 10.00am and 4.00pm on any working day from the date of this notice, but **not later than 4.00pm on Wednesday 3 April 2019** (Appointments for delivery of nominations are available from 01629 761335).
4. If an election is contested the poll will take place on **Thursday 2 May 2019**.
5. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration officer by 12 midnight on Friday 12 April 2019. Applications can be made online at www.gov.uk/register-to-vote
6. New applications to vote by post and requests to cancel or change an existing postal or proxy vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Derbyshire Dales District Council, Town Hall, Matlock DE4 3NN **by 5 pm on Monday 15 April 2019**
7. Applications to vote by proxy must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Derbyshire Dales District Council, Town Hall, Matlock DE4 3NN **by 5 pm on Wednesday 24 April 2019**
8. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Derbyshire Dales District Council, Town Hall, Matlock DE4 3NN **by 5 p.m. on 2 May 2019**. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday 24 April 2019. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday 24 April 2019.
