

Bakewell Safer Neighbourhood Team

During the month of December there were 2 vehicles seized from motorists in the Bakewell area. One of the motorists just had no licence and no insurance where the other one had no licence, no insurance and was arrested on suspicion of drug driving after being found in possession of cannabis. During the month of December the Anti Violence Bee made its appearance at Thornbridge Hall, Cromford Mills and Hall Leys Park in Matlock. The Anti-Violence Monument, which was originally created for Manchester, stands 11ft tall was created using various weapons, including knives and firearms, seized from the city's streets. The monument represents a firm stance against all forms of violence and the visit is set to highlight the force's dedication to preventing, and talking about, acts of violence. The Anti-Violence Bee Monument consists of 240 shotguns/ rifles, 273 handguns and over 3,000 blades. All weapons were transported by 7.5 lorry to the British Ironworks Centre where it took 2 years to build during lockdown. The same British Ironworks Centre also created Knife Angel which was seen in Derbyshire. We would like to thank all those people who visited and spoke to officers at the locations.
